

MEMBERS TIER DRAW

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Information on how to enter this Competition forms part of the terms and conditions of entry. Participation in this Competition is deemed acceptance of these terms and conditions of entry.
2. This Competition is being run by Doxa Community Club Inc (**DCC**) at:
 - a. Clocks - Shop 17, The Concourse, Flinders Street Station, Melbourne, VIC 3000; and
 - b. Central Point - 315 Elizabeth Street, Melbourne, VIC 3000.
3. Competition draw will take place on the second Wednesday of every month from 5:30pm until 7:30pm, unless otherwise altered or cancelled by DCC management. In such cases, notice will be given to Members.
4. Participation Eligibility and Exclusions:
 - a. Automatic Entry: All existing active Gold, Platinum and Diamond members of Doxa Rewards shall be entered into the Competition by default. Members who have self-excluded or been barred from the venues shall be ineligible.
 - b. Exclusion of Related Persons: Individuals categorised as related persons, encompassing directors, officers, employees, agents, servants, contractors, advisors, or owners are expressly prohibited from participating in this draw.
 - c. Consequences of Unintended Participation: In the event that a related person inadvertently takes part in the draw without the knowledge of DCC and their name is subsequently selected, they shall immediately forfeit any entitlement to a prize.
 - d. Membership Requirement: Members are required to maintain their active membership status to be eligible for prize claims.
 - e. Lapsed Membership Redraw: In the circumstance that a membership is found to be not up to date, a redraw of the Competition will be executed
5. The total prize pool is \$1,000, comprising two (2) x \$500 cash prizes and will commence at 5.30pm on the specified date.
6. The computer (via Ebet Membership Program & Outabox draw function) will select a Member's Name and Membership Badge Number at random.
7. Members must be at either Clocks at Flinders Street Station or Central Point Melbourne at the time of the draw to claim the prize. They will be required to present themselves to DCC Management within four (4) minutes of their Name and Membership Badge Number being called. If the Member is not present to claim the prize and does not let themselves known to

Management within the 4-minute time frame, it will be re-drawn.

8. Re-draws will take place in ten (10) minute intervals until a winner is found. Once a winner is found, the second draw will commence in the same manner until a second prize of \$500 is claimed. The re-draws will stop once a winner is present and has made themselves known to Management.
9. If no Member has claimed the prize by 7:30pm, Members' Names and Membership Badge Numbers will then be drawn from only the pool of Members who have swiped their Membership card at the bar tills or checked their points on a gaming machine between 5:30pm and 7:30pm.
10. Consecutive draws from this pool of Members who have swiped their Membership cards will take place every (4) minutes until an eligible Member is found.
11. Management reserves the right to require proof of identity and Membership card, as well as the right to disqualify any person who fails to provide the required information or who provides false information.
12. The winner will be given the option of winnings in the form of a cheque, cash or EFT. This cheque will be made out in the winner's full name; as shown on their Membership card.
13. Prize winners are advised that tax implications may arise as a result of accepting their prize. DCC is not responsible for such tax implications and prize winners should seek independent financial advice where necessary.
14. By accepting their prize, each prize winner acknowledges and consents to participating in promotional activities relating to the prize. These may include; promotional photograph shoots and media interviews. DCC may use all photographs and recorded interviews (including the prize winner's image, voice, name and other details), unless the prize winner expressly withdraws their consent.
15. If for any reason the Competition cannot run as planned, DCC may, in its sole discretion: cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the promotion and invalidate any affected entries deemed to be beyond its reasonable control. No refund, cash, or alternative tickets will be substituted for failure or the promotion or event to run. Members shall be advised if this occurs.
16. A Member may choose to opt out of the Competition, this will need to be done in writing and given to management at least three (3) hours before the first draw is to take place.
17. The prize must be paid to the winner within twenty-eight (28) days of the draw taking place.
18. DCC reserves the right to verify the eligibility of all Members and disqualify any Member who is found to have breached these Terms and Conditions.
19. Any guarantee or warranty given is in addition to any relevant statutory guarantees and warranties and nothing in these Terms and Conditions restricts, excludes, or modifies or

purports to restrict, exclude or modify any statutory consumer rights under any applicable law, particularly the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (Cth).

20. This Competition is subject to all applicable laws and regulations in Victoria, Australia.
